Old Business:

1. The minutes of the last meeting were read.

2. Guild Mistress Report
 - Since last meeting the guild has held a banner workshop and a C&I schola. Sir Yesungge has also expressed interest in doing a cooking workshop (TBA).
 - Several of the outstanding banners have been sold and there are 16 yet to be repainted from individuals who have notified the Guild Mistress that they do not wish to claim them. **Two/three individuals who said they wanted their banners have yet to make arrangements to pick them up. They should be contacted and given a deadline for pickup and payment. After the deadline those banners will be painted over**
3. Treasurers Report (Mistress Bess in absentia, was read by Mistress Gwenhwyfar)
 - We currently have 327.78 in the bank account
 - Money from the C&I Schola is outstanding
4. SOP's
 - As outlined in the last meeting, Mistress Gav and Mistress Elise were supposed to try and construct SOP's for the guild to cover elections, handling of the money and meetings. To date this project has not been completed. **Mistress Gav and Mistress Gwen volunteered to try and finish this project.**
5. The charter requires some modification with regard to the banners. **Mistress Elise will be asking the Ruantallan Scriptorium to see if these changes can be made.**

New Business:

1. The C&I Schola went very well, with 6 attendees and 1 cancellation. **Mistress Elise brought \$18.00 for the guild to deposit and presented this to Mistress Gwenhwyar to deliver to Mistress Bess.**

The Dabblers Guild has been presented the opportunity to do the lunch at BRC on April 25th. **Mary Elizabeth volunteered to organize the gathering of food donations from anyone willing to donate.** Donations should include an ingredients list and feed a minimum of 15 people. Cost shall be \$3.00. We will be serving food only (no beverages) and some food suggestions included bread, butter, tarts, veggies, cheese, stew/soup, etc. The lunch shall be advertised as a guild fundraiser and will be limited availability (first come first served).
